## Remedial classes "Terakoya"



### Aoba Group

For age 4 years old and up



Aoba group is one step up from wakaba group. This group made up for a few students class same as wakaba group. Children learn Japanese, arithmetic and ESL. For Japanese, children learn how to write basic essay in hiragana and katakana as well as reviewing hiragana. For arithmetic, children learn simple addition and subtraction, and aim to have Japanese elementary school entrance level.

- Writes essay in Katakana & Hiragana (basic)
- Vocabulary, Pronunciation, Reading
- Simple addition and subtraction
- How to read clock (exercise), numeral classifier and numbers (exercise). Others

### Wakaba Group

For age 3 years old and up



It is one step up from Futaba group and focusing on how to read and write both hiragana and numbers. Each class is 40 minutes long and learn Japanese, arithmetic and ESL. It made up for a few students class therefore we can raise children's individually and enhance a learning effects. Children need to sit during a class so Starchild will test before joining group to make sure children can sit for certain time and also test Japanese conversation level and understanding level in Japanese.
