



Starchild Terakoya Japanese, Math, Science, Swimming Summer School Program 2026

- Date/Hours : 8/3~8/28 (Mon~Fri) 4 weeks / 8 : 30AM~3 : 30PM (Extension until 5:30PM)
- Ages : 4 years old and up - The minimum requirement is to be able to understand Japanese.
- Participation Fee :

\$3,880 (1 month/20 days) \$970 (1 week/5 days) Applications will be accepted on a weekly basis. Fees for class materials and supplies are included, and fees for special programs such as field trips, swimming lessons, and extracurricular activities such as bus fare and entrance fees will be billed separately. (We will inform you of the finalized fee along with the detailed schedule around July.) First-time participants will be charged an additional \$350 to enter Terakoya. Day care, Mebae class, and Japanese class students and graduates are exempted from this fee.

- Programs :
 - ☆ Science by Dr. M, Terakoya Japanese, Terakoya Math, Japanese Culture, Star Child Music, and Art. Swimming lessons (One lane at the swimming pool will be rented out for the session, schedule to be announced later) Other Summer activities such as trips to the beach, museums, fruit picking, etc. Field trips are generally once a week.

• Payment & Registration

- ☆ Registration is accepted on a **weekly basis** as a standard unit.
- ☆ The **application deadline is Monday, June 15, 2026, at 12:00 PM.**
- ☆ Those who wish to participate must complete the Application & Agreement Form and submit it by email.
- ☆ Registration will be considered **official once tuition payment is confirmed via online transfer** (an invoice will be issued separately).
- ☆ Tuition includes the cost of teaching materials and supplies. Any additional expenses incurred for **special programs** (such as swimming lessons or field trip admission fees) will be charged separately. (Detailed schedules and confirmed fees will be announced around July.)
- ☆ **No make-up classes or refunds** will be provided for absences, regardless of the reason.
- ☆ If a payment is returned due to insufficient funds or other reasons, a **\$50 processing fee** will be charged.

☆ In the case of siblings participating during the same period (summer program only), a 5% discount on tuition will be applied to one child only.

☆ Enrollment will close **once capacity is reached**, in the order that tuition payments to be completed for each session.

☆ **Field trips and swimming lessons are mandatory for all children.** Children who are unable to participate due to health reasons will still attend and observe. Once registered, **fees are non-refundable and non-transferable**, including in cases of absence.

☆ After registration is completed, please submit the following forms: ① Blue Card Information Form, ② Medical Statement, ③ Napping Agreement, ④ Child Information Form.

Additionally, the Escort Form and Non-Medication Form may be required if applicable.

✘ **Please note that we may not be able to accept your child if all required documents are not submitted.**

• Important Information

☆ Drop-off begins at **8:20 AM**. Please ensure your child arrives by **8:40 AM**. If your child is expected to be late, please be sure to notify us in advance.

☆ Pick-up begins at **3:20 PM**. Please pick up your child by **3:40 PM**. If you expect to be late, please notify us in advance.

☆ If pick-up is **after 3:40 PM**, a **late fee of \$30** will apply starting at **3:41 PM**, followed by **\$30 per additional 10 minutes starting at 3:50 PM**. The same fee policy applies during **Extension ① pick-up time (4:20-4:40 PM)**. If pick-up exceeds **Extension ② pick-up time (5:20-5:40 PM)**, a late fee of **\$30** will apply starting at **5:41 PM**, followed by **\$10 per minute starting at 6:00 PM**.

☆ While we take every possible precaution regarding safety, we cannot be held responsible for injuries in the event of an accident. Please ensure that your child is **properly insured**.

☆ If a child's behavior significantly interferes with the program, we may consult with the family and take appropriate action as needed.

☆ As the facility is in a **residential area**, please be considerate of other residents after drop-off and pick-up. If you wish to socialize with other families, please do so **away from the entrance area**.

☆ Please **do not bring any nut products** in lunches or snacks. For allergy safety, do not include foods your child has **not eaten at home before**. If any nut products are brought, they will be **discarded immediately for safety reasons**. This policy applies not only on-site but also **after the summer program when children interact with others**.

☆ There may be **field trips or off-site childcare activities**. If you choose not to participate, your child will need to be absent, and **daycare services will not be available** on those days.

☆ On field trip days, we will **depart at 8:50 AM**. If arrival is **after 8:51 AM**, you will need to come directly to the field trip location or have your child be absent. In such cases, **care at Starchild will not be available**, and **no refunds or credits** will be issued.

☆ Program content and schedules may be **subject to change** depending on daily circumstances.

☆ Children may go outdoors during the program. If there are any precautions or special notes, please complete the forms provided.

☆ In the event of cancellation due to **severe weather**, make-up classes or refunds will generally **not be provided**. (Decisions regarding closure will be made by the school based on weather warnings and actual conditions.)

☆ Families who wish to store a stroller (within 23 inches wide) may use this optional service, available by advance reservation only and subject to space availability.

Fee: \$5 per stroller per day.

✘ Detailed schedules and notices regarding required items will be provided **around July**.

• **Healthy Policy**

☆ If your child has a temperature of 37.8° C (100° F) or higher, or if we determine that your child is unwell and unable to participate, your child will be required to stay home or be picked up.

☆ If your child has any allergies, please bring an EpiPen if necessary and inform us of the symptoms in advance.

☆ If there are any health conditions or special considerations we should be aware of, please notify us ahead of time.

☆ If your child has a cough, runny nose, or is not feeling well, please consider the health of other children and allow your child to rest at home instead of attending.

☆ Children **may not attend** if any of the following symptoms are observed:

- ① If your child' s underarm (axillary) temperature is 100° F (37.8° C) or higher
- ② If **24 hours have not passed since the fever subsided** (below 100° F / 37.8° C)
(Example: If a child is sent home early due to fever, they **may not attend the following day.**)
- ③ If symptoms such as **vomiting or diarrhea** are present
- ④ If your child has been diagnosed with a **contagious (infectious) disease**
*Please refer to the **following table** for infectious diseases that **require a doctor' s signature** before your child may return to school.

- ⑧ The school may be closed when it is judged necessary to disinfect or clean the school due to COVID, Flu, cold outbreak etc. staff health and safety management, special meetings to discuss how to respond to new regulations, inspections by the authorities, teacher training, etc.

- ★ At Starchild summer program, the **safety of all children is our top priority**, and we make decisions based on the whole picture. If you are not satisfied with our decision or do not agree with it, you may be asked to leave the school.
- ★ In the event of a **lockdown, the children will only be picked up by walk or car you arranged otherwise the Daycare bus (extra charge may apply)**.
- ★ If your child's name is not written on his/her belongings, we will write it directly on the item.
- ★ We will post your child's name and face which are hidden on public Instagram (@strachildny6st).
- ★ Please refrain from requesting personal sitters, etc. from the teachers.
- ★ The inspectors from other organizations will be coming without any notice.
- ★ We use pictures of children in promotional videos with their backs and faces obscured.
- ★ Please note that we will not reimburse you for any loss or damage to your belongings, although we will take sufficient caution.
- ★ The fee for animal feed and special programs included in the field trip fee is non-refundable for any reason (including if your child refuses to participate in a special experience in the field trip / activities since we respect the children's decision. and also, they do not attend the field trip).
